The topic is dedicated to children and young people of different times, societies, religions and classes. The aim is to discuss living conditions, children worlds, the places of children in the family as well as in the Balkan societies, the historical forms of relationships between parents and children: motherhood and fatherhood, adoption and foster care in their cultural context.

A special attention is paid to biopolitics toward children and mothers: measures to reduce the infant mortality, to improve children and maternal health, as well as to eugenic ideas about classifying children.

We offer to discuss:

- The state of art of the child history researches on the Balkans.
- Children in families, neighborhoods and small entities on the Balkans.
- Children realms: games, labor, school in the process of modernization.
- Growing up in poverty. Child care and surviving in the past.
- Children in the different religions.
- Childhood and youth in villages and towns.
- Growing up as a girl/boy. Gender aspects of education on the Balkan.
- Children without parents. Historical forms of adoption and foster care. Neglected children.
- Educating children emotions. Arts and children. Children and young people in media, advertisements and industry.
- Children and "classifying thinking" in the modern time: "gifted" children and "children with special needs". Educational models of childhood and their implementation.
- Children in risk. Deviant behavior of children and youth. Combating juvenile criminality.
- Visualization of childhood. Visible and invisible groups in society.
- The state and the children: political uses of children and youth. The "happy childhood" in the political propaganda.
